Central Australian Stolen Generations and Strehlow Research Centre Enter Into Important MOU

Allan (Oopy) Campbell, Chairperson at the Central Australian Stolen Generations and Families Aboriginal Corporation (CASG&FAC) and David Ritchie, CEO Dept. of Natural Resources, Environment & the Arts will sign a MOU between CASG&FAC and the Strehlow Research Centre (SRC). The MOU will formalise closer working arrangements between CASG&FAC and the SRC.

The MOU signing will take place at the CASG&FAC Office at 86 Hartley Street at 8:30am on Friday 9 June 2006.

Oopy Campbell said 'The Strehlow Research Centre holds a wealth of family tree information that is extremely important, when used with government records, to help members of the Stolen Generations find their family, their home and their place. The MOU signifies the commitment of both organisations to make effective use of the information in the collection.'

A key feature of the MOU is a commitment by CASG&FAC to encourage clients who access the Family Tracing & Reunion Service it operates in Alice Springs to assist staff at the SRC to update family tree information.
